Here are some short and vivid news of Father's Home, dedicated to the new home of the younger children in Anto village, a 2.8 hectares size green land.

On Sunday 27th January of this year, we officially inaugurated the new site. It was the opportunity to invite some friends and the village authorities. A few of our dear



and faithful Danish partners were present. After a time of prayer and worship, several persons spoke. The representative of the tribal village chief honoured us with his presence, sharing encouraging words and



thanking us for the “good work realized” in his community.

In fact, it is one of the poorest in the Shama district; after that, snacks and beverages were offered, followed by a time of dance and rejoicing on a rhythmical music.

After four years of building work, we are very grateful to finally be able to use the new premises and are satisfied about this positive development!

One of the main projects of this year is the establishment of a chicken farm situated at the back of the house. Indeed, Father's Home has been thinking about a self-financing way to support the ministry for some time now.

We have decided to start this small and middle scale size project to start with. We do now have a land at our disposal and two trusted men ready to invest some of their time in the

They have practical and theoretical knowledge about agriculture.

The idea is to build a chicken farm with 150 broilers and 150 layers, so to say 300 fowl to start with.

We take this opportunity to thank all those who already and specifically gave money in order to set up the place and purchase the chicken.

It is great to have ambassadors outside Ghana, who invest their precious time in this ministry. We are so grateful about it!
