As most of you know, we have been working on **setting up a 2 storey building on a new land at Anto**, which is a village 40 minutes drive away from our present site at Butumagyebu direction the capital city, Accra. **The site has a size of 6.92 acres and a lot of nature all around.**

Our desire is to make Father's Home Care Ministries grow, the long term vision being a children's village able to welcome up to hundred children in need.



The first building is now finished; it contains four flats of 5 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms, a hall, a kitchen and a dining room each. We are so happy to share with you the joy of **the completion as well as the moving in it!**

We have decided to **keep the present site and turn it into a centre named Father's Home Care Ministries Youth Development Centre.**

The teenagers and young adults are therefore staying there with some of the parents to surround and monitor them.

The younger children, from age 2 to 12 are moving to Anto together with 2 young and dynamic couples in a family setting, keeping the original name of Father's Home Care Ministries Children's Home; each couple is taking take care of 6-7 children.
